SESSION LESSONS

Sessions may be registered for by filling out the enclosed form, and returning it no later than June 14. Exceptions to this registration procedure must be cleared through the clubhouse and not at the tennis courts where it could disrupt lessons. Classes may be limited so sign up early. Additional session lessons can be added if there is greater demand.

Beginner (Ages 4-9)

Tuesday & Thursday 12:30 p.m. to 1:30 p.m.

Minimum of 3 per class. Fee is \$9.00 per group lesson with a minimum charge of 4 lessons (or \$36.00).

Intermediate (Ages 9-13)

Tuesday & Thursday 1:30 p.m. to 2:30 p.m.

Minimum of 3 per class. Fee is \$9.00 per group lesson with a minimum charge of 4 lessons (or \$36.00).

Advanced (High School Varsity or Junior Varsity)

Tuesday & Thursday 2:30 p.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Minimum of 3 per class. Fee is \$9.00 per group lesson with a minimum charge of 4 lessons (or \$36.00).

Adult Group Lessons

Thursday 8:30 a.m. to 10:00 a.m.

Minimum of 2 for this class. Fee is \$12 per group lesson with a minimum charge of 4 lessons or (\$48.00).

This class is for anyone who wants to meet new friends and get fit with tennis. The class will be designed to meet the needs of each member at whatever skill level you may currently be playing. It's a great place to get started playing or get back into tennis if you haven't been playing. The classes will begin June 3.

Private lessons fees will be charged unless your instructor is notified no later than 7:00 a.m. on the day the lesson was scheduled. Please make sure you touch base personally to cancel your lessons.

2010 Staff – I am pleased to announce that nearly the entire lifeguard/instructor and cabana staff is returning for the 2010 pool season. Alyssa Streck, Christopher Jumes, Kaitlyn Skalet, Laura Rammer and Michelle Rammer are the full time lifeguard/swimming instruction staff, along with Sarah Bauer, Mike Bauer and Elizabeth Meier as swim instructors. Martha Meier and Katrina Rojo are both returning to the cabana. On behalf of myself, Brad Disch and the entire pool staff we look forward to seeing all members at the pool on opening day Friday, June 4, 2010.

The wading pool is now “V.G.B.” compliant and ready for opening day. The demo work was started in November 2009 and thanks to Mother Nature we finished one month ahead of schedule on April 7. The entire wading pool was given a new coat of plaster. Two very colorful fish were added near the new drain to attract the attention of our young swimmers away from the main drain. The annual maintenance and repairs to the big pool are also ahead of schedule thanks to our warm weather.

SWIMMING POOL REGULATIONS

These rules have been formulated to assure safe and sanitary operations of the pool facilities. Parents are requested to familiarize themselves with the rules and to instruct their children and guests to observe and obey all instructions of the pool lifeguards and club personnel.

Three “PLEAs” for All Swimmers

Please don’t swim when you have diarrhea. You can spread germs in the water and make other people sick. This is especially important for kids in diapers.

Please don’t swallow the pool water. In fact, avoid getting water in your mouth.

Please practice good hygiene. Take a shower before swimming and wash your hands after using the toilet or changing diapers. Germs on your body end up in the water.

POOL HOURS AND SEASON

The pool officially opens the Friday after Memorial Day (June 4) and closes Labor Day (September 6). Members will be notified if there are any exceptions. The swimming pool is open for general swim Monday through Friday from 12 noon until 6:00 p.m. all days except Wednesdays and Thursdays which is from 12:00 noon until 7:30 p.m. (Monday, June 7 and Monday August 23 & 30 the pool will be closed.) Please know the pool may close earlier depending upon weather conditions. No one is to swim or be in the pool area unless a lifeguard is on duty.

SWIM LESSONS

Swim lessons will be held on Tuesday and Friday during two separate sessions. **All four levels of instruction (pre-beginner, beginner, intermediate, and advanced) will be offered at each time slot. Space will be limited and reserved on a first-come, first-serve basis.** Lesson times will be as follows:

10:30 a.m. – 11:00 a.m. 11:00 a.m. – 11:30 a.m. 11:30 a.m. – 12 noon

In addition to the above named classes we will again offer a **Lifeguard Training Preview I and II**. This class is for kids who would like to learn the skills of a lifeguard who have successfully passed all of the advanced requirements and are 12 years of age or above. **This class will be held during the 11:30am time slot only.** However, this is a two-session course, so students who have successfully completed session one may enroll in session two. No new enrollments will be taken for session two without the successful completion of session one.

Session II	July 20-August 13

(Swim lessons are \$40.00 for each session.)

LAP SWIMMING

Lap swimming is available on Thursday and Saturday from 11:15 a.m. to 12:00 noon.

GUESTS

Guest fees are \$4.00 for adults, \$2.50 for children under 12 and under, for each visit. Grandchildren of members under the age of 12 will not be charged a fee. There is a sign up sheet located in the entryway to the pool to register your guests. Your account will be billed at the end of the month.

***PRIVATE POOL PARTIES** - Private pool parties are available after normal pool operating hours.

POOL SAFETY RULES and REGULATIONS

- 1) Running, pushing, wrestling, ball playing, or causing undue disturbance will not be permitted in or about the pool areas.
- 2) Use of kiddie pool will be limited to children under 6 years of age in swimsuits. Children must be accompanied by an adult.
- 3) **Large rafts and inner tubes are not allowed and all water equipment and toys will be subject to approval by pool personnel.**

Parents are requested to familiarize themselves with the rules and to caution their children to observe and obey all instructions of the pool director and lifeguards. Failure to comply with these rules will be considered cause for suspension of pool privileges.

1. Boisterous conduct on the pool deck or roughhousing in the pool will not be tolerated.
2. **LIFEGUARDS AND CLUB PERSONNEL ARE NOT TO BE CONSIDERED BABY SITTERS.**
3. **All members and guests must register before entering the pool.**
4. Street shoes, breakable containers, and soap are not allowed in the pool area.
5. **Children under 8 years of age will not be permitted within the pool area unless accompanied by an adult. Children between 8 and 10 years of age will be permitted within the pool area unaccompanied only if they have passed the basic swim test and have submitted written permission from their parents to the Pool Director.**

The basic swim test consists of:

- a) **Swimming two lengths of the pool.**
 - b) **Floating for one minute.**
 - c) **Treading water for two minutes.**
6. No adults or children in swimming attire will be allowed outside the fenced swimming pool area, or in the golf range area.
 7. Members must bring their own towels to the pool.
 8. It is not permissible to reserve chaise lounge chairs at the pool.

POOL SANITATION RULES

- 1) Swimmers must shower before entering the pool.
- 2) Admission shall be refused to anyone with skin abrasions, colds, coughs, inflamed eyes, infections, or wearing bandages.
- 3) **Children that are not fully potty trained are REQUIRED to wear plastic pants while in any pool.**
- 4) **Changing of clothing, diapers and swimming attire must be confined to the locker rooms.**
- 5) All refuse is to be placed in appropriate containers.
- 6) Pets cannot be allowed inside the fenced area.

FOOD & BEVERAGE RULES

- 1) All food is to be consumed in the fenced grass area.
- 2) No food or refreshments of any kind are permitted in the pool area except as provided by Club facilities and under Club supervision or doctor prescribed diets.
- 3) No glass containers anywhere.
