


# MEN'S GOLF FUND







Thursday, July 20th through Saturday, July 22nd

This is the Club's premier Member/Guest event of the season and a great way to entertain a client, friend or family member for 3 days of great golf, food & beverage and camaraderie. The event will begin with a 1:30 pm 18 hole Shotgun on Thursday. Followed by two 10:00 am Shotgun Starts on Friday and Saturday. Field is limited to the first 60 teams and teams that participated the prior year will have priority in signing up. The field will be comprised of 10 flights of 6 determined by total team handicap index. Every player must have an established Handicap.

**Format:** All six 9 Hole matches will be Net Best Ball Matches withing your flight. The first 5 matches will be played against the other 5 teams in your flight and match 6 will pit 1 vs 2, 3 vs 4 and 5 vs 6 in point totals in each flight. 1 point for every hole won, 1/2 point for every hole lost. 1 point for winning the match, 1/2 point for a match that is tied. Maximum of 6 points for a match won to keep the flights point totals close together.

The 10 flight winners plus the two other highest point earning teams will qualify for the shootout. 5 teams will play on hole # 1 and 5 teams will play on hole # 10 with 4 total teams eliminated.
