TENNIS FACILITIES

The Club has one tennis court, located directly adjacent to the pool area.

GOLF HIGHLIGHTS

MEN'S SHOTGUNS: *Butte des Morts has several shotgun events for male members. This is a nice way for new Members to meet fellow BDM golfers. The Club encourages all golfing Members to play in these events. The shotguns are blind draw mixers with A, B, C, and D players teaming together.*

WOMEN'S EVENTS: *The women at Butte des Morts have their own golf committee and events. The Women's Golf Group plays every Wednesday morning at 9:00 a.m. A New Member's Kickoff Meeting will be held in April to welcome all the new golfing women to the Club. At this meeting you will meet the Women's Committee, Club Manager, and Club Professional.*

JUNIOR GOLF: *Golfing and Social Members may sign-up their children for Junior Golf Lessons which start in early June and continue into August. Grandparents may sign up their grandchildren as well for Junior Golf Lessons. The only requirement is that your child must be eight years of age or older on or before December 31st. Tuesday is the Club's weekly junior golf day. Lunch is available immediately after Junior golf and will be served in the Grille. Parents of children in the junior golf program have an obligation to walk for your 2, 5 and 9 holer. It is a great way for your children to enjoy learning the great game of golf. We also have a "No holer" program for younger juniors. The Junior Program is an introductory program touching on the basic swing fundamentals as well as rules, safety, and etiquette.*

MEN'S SHOOTOUT: *This event is open to all male golfing members. Pods of 5-7 golfers, grouped by handicap, will tee off. The highest net score will be eliminated on each hole. Ties will be broken by a chip-off. The pod winners will then merge and play the same format until a champion is crowned.*

MEMBER-GUEST: *The annual BDM Member-Guest is the premier Club event. This event is designed to entertain you and your Guest. Butte des Morts does an excellent job of showcasing the Club; you will be proud to entertain your Guests during this event. Each Member and his or her Guest receives a gift upon registration. This is a three-day event held at the of July. The format will be a round-robin team best ball match play event, flighted by combined handicap. Flight winners and one "lucky dog" team will advance to a shootout. This showcase event is open to social members of the club who have an established handicap.*

PRESIDENT'S CUP: *This men's event is an individual low net and low gross tournament that is held the second week in July over a 2 week period. You are allowed to play one time during the specified days of this tournament. Merchandise credit will be awarded.*

CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP: *BDM has a men's medal play club championship. This is a flighted event consisting of 36 holes. The men's senior event will also be held in conjunction with the regular medal play championship. The senior event is open to all male golfing members that are 50 or older by the day of competition. Tee times and pairings are assigned. Merchandise credit will be awarded.*

The Club also has a men's and women's match play club championship. This event is flighted by handicap. Merchandise credit will be awarded.

EVAN'S FOURBALL EIGHTSOME: *This is a handicapped, couples, alternate shot event. The event is a fund raiser for the Evan's Scholarship Foundation. Members form their own teams and couples may mix partners. Merchandise credit will be awarded upon the completion of play.*

MEMBER-MEMBER: *This event is held the last weekend in June. Members are encouraged to find their own member partner. 36 holes of competition: Saturday is a 2 person, handicapped scramble; Sunday is a handicapped 2 person four-ball (best ball).*

There is a Hors d'oeuvre Reception Saturday evening. Separate divisions for the men and women. Awards will follow play on Sunday.

JUNIOR 37: A non-voting Membership limited to Members between the age of 37-40. Junior 37 Members and their Family have full use of all the Club's facilities and services, including the golf course, pool, tennis courts and Clubhouse. (Oldest eligible member.)

Quarterly Minimum - \$330

Initiation Fee - \$3,500

Capital Improvement Monthly Fee - \$45

CLUB: A non-voting Membership that allows Club Members and their Family use of the Club's pool, tennis courts and Clubhouse. (Golf 5 times a season; 3 times paying green fees; 2 additional guest of a golf member paying green fees.)

CORPORATE CLUB: A Membership that allows Corporate Members and their Family use of the Club's pool, tennis courts and Clubhouse.

JUNIOR ASSOCIATE: A non-voting Membership designed for the children of Members who are unmarried, 18 to 23 years of age, and either live at home with their parents or are full-time students. They are entitled to the privileges according to the Membership category of their parents and the By-Laws.
